2. The number of the clause which requires the data is shown in the left hand column for each statement however other clauses may also use the same data
3. Where a form field like this [] appears, data is required to be inserted relevant to the option selected. Click on the form field **once** and type in the data. Otherwise complete by hand and in ink.

Completion of the data in full, according to Options chosen, is essential to create a complete contract.
