BACKGROUND

TCTA utilises the Sage 300 Finance system as a core financial management platform, together with various integrated third-party software components. The original contractual arrangement for the system was only for Sage licences. Two variation orders were approved to increase the scope of the contract to include Sage upgrade, support and maintenance, Orchid Systems installation. The last variation order was approved for support and maintenance only.

Following further contractual amendments, the scope of the current contract was limited to support and maintenance services only. The software licences procured under the prior variation remain in use; however, they are not covered under the existing contractual arrangement and are approaching expiry. The majority of the third-party software licences are due to expire in July 2026, while the Sage 300 Finance Premium licences are scheduled to expire in September 2026.

Failure to procure replacement licences presents a risk of service disruption to critical financial systems. This requisition is therefore submitted to facilitate the procurement of the required Sage 300 Finance and integrated third-party software licences to ensure continuity of operations and system stability.

SCOPE OF WORK

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF GOODS/SERVICES

SAGE 300 Finance system licences:

Sage 300 Finance Premium, Sage 300 Account Payable and Account Receivable, Sage 300 Intelligent Reporting Connector, Sage 300 Intelligence Reporting Report Designer, General Ledger, Global Search, Notes, Multiple Contacts, Transaction Analysis and Optional Filed Creator, Reverse Charges and Withholding Taxes, Subscription Features, System Manager, Web Screens and G/L Consolidations.

Third-party licences:

Third-party licences including, but not limited to: Orchid Extender, Orchid Systems Process Scheduler, Sage Enterprise Intelligence (SEI) License Server, Sage Enterprise Intelligence Distribution, Sage 300 Enterprise Intelligence ETL - Consolidation, SEI Users, Cashbook Premium ERP, EFTXpress for Cashbook, Lanpac Premium Users.

COMPANY EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

The Bidder must be a certified Sage Business Partner with the capabilities to provide Sage and third-party related licences. Additionally, the bidder must have the knowledge of installing the licences on Sage 300 Finance system.

PERSONNEL EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

The Bidder must assign a suitably qualified and experienced personnel capable of installing the licences on Sage 300 Finance system.

Renew Licensing for Sage 300 Finance and third-party related licenses.

Proof of accreditation as a Certified Sage Business Partner and a third-party related licence reseller.

Where a B-BBEE Certificate is issued by a withdrawn verification agency, no points will be awarded as the B-BBEE Certificate will be deemed invalid.

1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.
