3.3 TECHNICAL EVALUATION STAGES

k) This will be a desktop evaluation of the mandatory requirements. Products will be evaluated individually. Each tender needs to meet the entire mandatory technical

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requirements to proceed to evaluation stage 2, a "NO" to any of the mandatory requirements as listed below will lead to immediate disqualification.

3.4 Scoring functional Criteria (Annexure A)

The tenderer needs to obtain a weighted score of **95%** in order to pass this Evaluation phase. Requirements shall be scored as shown on table below:

Functionality Evaluation will follow the following process:

- Evaluate the submissions against the functional criteria
- Rate each submission against each criterion
- Apply weightings and calculate total functional score
- Eliminate tenders below the minimum threshold

3.15 Evaluation of price

Step 4 – Price and Preference (Evaluation of price and Specific goals)

- The 80/20 preference points system will be used to evaluate price. Price points will be calculated out of 80 for price (Evaluated price including VAT). A maximum of 20 points will be awarded to a tenderer for the specific goal.
- The reverse e-auction will be utilised to achieve market related prices. Where
 market related price is not achieved at close of reverse e-auction, Eskom reserves
 the right to negotiate market related prices with the highest ranked supplier.
- Tenderers will submit a complete tender <u>without</u> prices as stated in the enquiry where reverse e-auction is applicable.

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- The enquiry/tender document will clearly stipulate that Eskom reserve the right to use reverse e-auction. The relevant documents (e.g. Reverse E-auction Training Acknowledgement Form, Reverse E-auction process and bidders guide for reverse e-auction with training video links) will be included with the tender.
- E-auction will run for at least 1 working day. At the clearly specified date and time, the auction will close.
- In an event that the reverse e-auction is not possible due to various reasons, the transaction shall default to the normal process of requesting the price quotation in evaluate the price as per PPR 2022.
- The points scored for the specific goal will be added to the points scored for price and the total will be rounded off to the nearest two decimal places. The contract must be awarded to the tenderer scoring the highest points unless objective criteria if any justify the award to another tenderer. The ranking will be based on the estimated value per item /SAP number.
- The contract/s will be awarded to the highest ranked supplier/s based on the highest points scored per item, in terms of the PPR 2022 unless objective criteria justify the award to another tenderer

3.17 Evaluation of Specific Goals

Specific Goals

A maximum of 20 points may be awarded to a tenderer for the specific goal specified for the tender. The points scored for the specific goal must be added to the points scored for price and the total must be rounded off to the nearest two decimal places. Subject to section 2(1)(f) of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, the contract must be awarded to the tenderer scoring the highest points.

Tenderer/ tenderers recommended for award, including those justified on the bases of objective criteria, must still meet Contractual requirements as set out in the enquiry. Contractual requirements are not evaluation criteria. They are required to be met and assessed after the evaluation and ranking of the tenders.

The tenderer will be allowed <u>7 working days</u>, to resubmit the contractual requirements that were not met after the tender submission. This is aligned to the SHEQ requirements for the Procurement and Supply Chain Management process in Eskom Revision 2.

The process further states that for SHEQ as a contractual requirement, each supplier will only be evaluated twice before the final report is submitted to the Procurement Practitioner. However, should any further tender evaluations be required, the Procurement Manager will submit a motivation and supporting documentation for the request to the relevant Safety, Health, Environment, Quality (SHEQ) Senior Manager for approval.

Tenderers failing to meet contractual requirements will be ineligible for contract award.

a) Financial Analysis

Where applicable the financial viability assessment of the tenderers and its ability to meet its contractual obligations for the duration of the contract will be conducted by Financial and Management Reporting (within Group Finance).

- The tenderers must submit the latest and approved financial statement not older than 18 months after year end, as per requirements of company law.
