1. INTRODUCTION

The Atlantis Special Economic Zone (ASEZ) was designated as such by the Minister of Trade and Industry on the 19 October 2018 and the license to operate the zone was granted to the Western Cape Government (MEC for Finance and Economic Development). In response to this, and in accordance with the license conditions, the Atlantis Special Economic Zone Company (ASEZ Co) was set-up by the Western Cape Government in partnership with the City of Cape Town. This establishment followed due process and the company was registered in March 2020.

The ASEZ is a geographical area of 118 hectares in the industrial area of Atlantis. It is a Greentech SEZ with the objective of attracting Greentech manufacturers. The ASEZ currently consists of a number of investors on privately owned land (about 25ha) as well as three separate portions of vacant and industrial zoned land owned by the City of Cape Town (+-93ha). This land is in the process of being acquired from the City of Cape Town.

The Atlantis SEZ has been identified as a strong manufacturing node in Atlantis and the Western Cape, with Greentech a key emerging sector for the Western Cape and for South Africa.

The Atlantis community and industrial area was established by the Apartheid government as a group areas Coloured township and people forcibly removed from suburbs in Cape Town were relocated here (amongst other areas). The government also created attractive incentives for industrial manufacturing in Atlantis. When these incentives and subsidies were removed, it led to a slump in manufacturing in the nineties. Since then, the City of Cape Town, working with National and provincial government, has been actively exploring ways to stimulate new industrial investment in Atlantis. Prior to Atlantis being designated a Special Economic Zone, the city had designated the area as a green manufacturing hub. The ASEZ aims to contribute to green industrial development in Atlantis and the area will no doubt become a key platform for Greentech industrial development in the Western Cape.

ASEZCo is a provincial public entity under the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) situated in the Cape Town CBD. We are required under the PFMA to acquire a banking facility which consist of a commercial bank operating under the SA Bank Act.

2. TERMS OF REFERENCE

2.1 SCOPE OF WORK

2.1.1 Background

The Atlantis Special Economic Zone Company SOC Ltd (ASEZCo) is a multi-government investment project focused on stimulating investment in manufacturing and services in the green and clean technology space. The ASEZCo's overarching mandate is to attract key investors in the Greentech industry, in order to foster and grow the Green Economy within the Western Cape, whilst enhancing the local economic environment and job opportunities and creating an integrated and sustainable future for Atlantis. The ASEZCo is a Schedule 3D

state-owned company established in terms of Section 25 of the Special Economic Zones Act (Act 16 of 2014)

The ASEZCo undertook a detailed Strategic Human Resources Organisational Design Process in 2019 when the organisation commenced its operations and put governance structures in place.

At this time, the organisation was being incubated within Wesgro and the Human Resources Strategy was developed, in line with the overarching Strategic Plan and Corporate Plan of the ASEZCo. The organisational structure was part of this strategy and was designed to support the start-up phase of the organisation for a 3–5-year period.

Subsequently, the ASEZCo has commenced operating independently since April 2020, and was gazetted as a government business enterprise in terms of the PFMA on 20 December 2021. This has resulted in some changes in our operations, particularly in our infrastructure Development Department, as our investor attraction process has become more robust, and our Infrastructure Development has commenced within the Zone.

2.1.2 ASEZCo's primary objective in issuing this RFQ is to enter into agreement with a successful bidder(s) who will achieve the following:

a) to revise some of the roles and requirements within the organisation, in line with our new areas of focus.

2.2 Service Requirements

2.2.1 General

The successful bidder will be required to provide the following:

The service to be provided to ASEZCO must meet the following minimum requirements:

2.2.2 A comprehensive online management system incorporating:

- a. Undertake an Organisational Structure Review including engagement with all business unit heads and relevant personal on proposed changes to the organisational structure, with particular focus on the Infrastructure Development Business Unit, operational requirements and integrated application of the living lab/greentech/green finance components.
- b. Design a new organogram to support the ASEZCo for the next 3-5 years.
- c. Develop the new job profiles as required (approx. 10 roles maximum).

- d. Undertake job grading & benchmarking of the new roles.
- e. Present the project results to the Board and/or relevant Executives.

2.3 DURATION

2.3.1 The duration of this contract is not expected to be longer than 3 months.

The Greentech definition includes, but is not limited to, technologies relating to renewable energy, energy storage, energy efficiency, water efficiency and management, greener packaging, recycling / re-use (i.e., circular economy), and green chemicals.

The definition of a resource-efficient producer is one that employs processes, products, and services to increase the resource-efficiency of production and to reduce pollution and minimise negative impacts on humans and the environment.

 - 1.3.2. B-BBEE Status Level of Contributor.
- 1.4. The maximum points for this bid are allocated as follows:
