1. BACKGROUND

The Eastern Cape Office of the Premier has identified leadership mentoring and coaching programme as a key intervention for addressing critical human resource challenges such as mismatch of skills, limited capacity and capabilities of employees, the impact of future retirement rates, youth empowerment, and aging workforce.

The program has been deemed necessary for the department considering that there is no succession planning in place whilst the above challenges endure it and can contribute to a risk of losing institutional memory. Seven (7) Youth and twelve (12) Middle Management employees have been identified as beneficiaries of this programme for the period of 9 months.

It is therefore envisaged that leadership mentoring and coaching program will enable the department amongst others to:

- Develop and strengthen the leadership and management of the Office of the Premier
- Promote skills enhancement and career development,
- Promote professional identity,
- Enhance attraction and retention of employees,
- Knowledge management and knowledge transfer,
- Enhance a positive employee culture and work ethic.

2. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this RFQ is to appoint an accredited service provider that will develop and manage a structured leadership mentoring and coaching programme to develop mentees' leadership skills, assist them to achieve career goals, and to advance in department.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The Service provider is expected to develop and implement leadership coaching and mentoring program including a detailed process on how the coaching and mentoring will be delivered. It must include the follow as part of the program



3.1 Phase 1 – Self- discovery assessment

- 3.1.1 Conduct competency assessment for every mentee
- 3.1.2 Customized plan for every mentee
- 3.1.3 Identify and pair experienced mentors/coaches for each mentee to implement the customized plan

3.2 Phase 2 - Strengthening of interpersonal skills (group coaching)

- 3.2.1 Strengthen the emotional intelligence capabilities of the mentees
- 3.2.2 Enhance Problem solving and critical thinking skills
- 3.2.3 Communication skills
- 3.2.4 Access to networking events and conferences
- 3.2.5 Opportunities to connect with other program participants
- 3.2.6 Change management

3.3 Phase 3 - Organisational competencies

Capacitate mentees on the following:

- 3.3.1 Strategic capabilities and leadership
- 3.3.2 Expert and technical management skills
- 3.3.3 Monitoring and evaluation
- 3.3.4 People management and empowerment program
- 3.3.5 Financial management
- 3.3.6 Change management

3.4 Phase 4 - Monitoring and Evaluation

- 3.4.1 Regular feedback sessions to ensure program meets participant needs
- 3.4.2 Evaluation of coaching and mentoring effectiveness
- 3.4.3 Assessment of program impact on participant career advancement and leadership growth



4. EXPECTED DELIVERABLES

The Service provider must deliver the following:

- 4.1 An overview of the assessment approach on how they will successfully implement the assessment and management of leadership mentoring programme process.
- 4.2 A project plan outlining activities that make up the expected deliveries.
- 4.3 Provide Office of the Premier with a comprehensive individual assessment reports with recommended actions and developmental areas.
- 4.4 Provide individual and team feedback sessions as per assessment results and mentorship programme.
- 4.5 Develop and present a final report with recommendations based on findings and supported by best practices.
- 4.6 All reports and assessment results remain the intellectual property of the Office of the Premier and must be handed over to the department as part of the leadership Assessment Close out report.
- 4.7 Mentees must be issued with competency certificates and indicate accreditation with existing SAQA approved qualifications/ courses/ unit standards.

5. COMPETENCY AND EXPERTISE REQUIREMENTS

Service providers are required to adhere to the following requirements:

- 5.1 Service providers must have an extensive knowledge and understanding of leadership development and career advancement.
- 5.2 Service providers must have a minimum of 10 years' experience in mentoring and coaching/ coaching leadership.
- 5.3 Service providers must submit reference letters as evidence of related services previously and successfully conducted. The Reference Letter(s) must be in the letterhead of the previously serviced client and should reflect at least name of the client, description of the services rendered, value of the project, year conducted, year completed, contactable reference name and contact details.



5.4 Service providers/ mentors must possess a Comensa Senior Practitioner or Comensa Master Practitioner professional certificate in coaching (Coaches and mentors of South Africa).

- (d) **“tender for income-generating contracts”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) **“the Act”** means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

3. FORMULAE FOR PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES

3.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

3.1.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

$$P_s = 80 \left(1 - \frac{P_t - P_{min}}{P_{min}} \right) \quad \text{or} \quad P_s = 90 \left(1 - \frac{P_t - P_{min}}{P_{min}} \right)$$

Where

P_s = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

P_t = Price of tender under consideration



P_{min} = Price of lowest acceptable tender

3.2. FORMULAE FOR DISPOSAL OR LEASING OF STATE ASSETS AND INCOME GENERATING PROCUREMENT

3.2.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

$$Ps = 80 \left(1 + \frac{Pt - P_{max}}{P_{max}} \right) \quad \text{or} \quad Ps = 90 \left(1 + \frac{Pt - P_{max}}{P_{max}} \right)$$

Where

Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

Pt = Price of tender under consideration

P_{max} = Price of highest acceptable tender

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:

4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—

- (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
- (b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system, then the organ of state must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for both the 90/10 and 80/20 preference point system.
