1. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum is to report on incorrect tender closing date and request the extension of the closing date as per the compulsory site briefing meeting held on 10 February 2026.

2. Background

The following tenders were tabled and approved by Bid Specification Committee (BSC) on 03 December 2025, with an approved advert date of 30 January 2026, and the closing date of 20 February 2026. However, both tenders were advertised on National Treasury ePortal on 04 February 2026, with two closing dates, which is 20 February 2026 on the document and 06 March 2026 on the advert page. Affected tenders are listed below.

32502 (5U) - VSD Energy Savings Projects at uShaka Marine World.

34169 (5U) - The Supply, Conceptualisation, Development, Design, Implementation and Management of the UMW Customer Loyalty Programme.

3. Site Briefing Outcome

During the compulsory site briefing held on 10 February 2026 at 11:00, for 32502 (5U) VSD's Energy Saving Projects at uShaka Marine World, bidders raised concerns regarding the

incorrect closing date as advertised. Bidders further requested that the closing date be extended to allow adequate time to prepare and submit compliant bids.

The incorrect closing date may negatively affect bidders' participation and compromise the fairness of the tender process. Granting an extension will ensure transparency and fairness and provide bidders with sufficient time to prepare responsive bids.

4. Recommendation

It is recommended that the tender closing date for both tenders listed above be extended from 20 February 2026 to 06 March 2026. An official addendum should be issued to all prospective bidders who attended the compulsory site briefing for both tenders.
