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SCOPE OF WORK:

The service is for the provision of road transport services for Limestone from Highveld Siding to Kusile Power Station, estimated at 29.2 km, on an as and when required by Eskom from 31 March 2024 to 30 November 2026.

The Tenderer must have sufficient vehicles to move up to 36 000 tons per month. The tenderer must take note that the volumes will fluctuate on a monthly basis. It is estimated that the initial volumes will be approximately 5 000 tons per month in FY24 and will ramp up to approximately 36 000 tons per month as all Kusile units become operational.

- The tenderer must provide proof of vehicle ownership/lease, (in the form of certified vehicle registration documents in the name of the supplier/ shareholder/s.
- The tenderer must provide a certified road worthy certificate(s) valid at the time of tender for each truck specified on the project plan.

Eskom's requirements for the service

Eskom will use its best endeavours to grant access to the Vehicles for the purpose of Delivery between 06h00 and 22hh00 on Mondays to Friday and 06h00 to 17h30 on Saturday and Sunday. Should circumstances require any changes to be made to this arrangement, the Parties shall discuss such at monthly meetings.

The service includes:

Trucks will be allowed to operate between 06h00 and 22hh00 on Mondays to Friday and 06h00 to 17h30 on Saturday and Sunday. Should circumstances require any changes to be made to this arrangement, the Parties shall discuss such at monthly meetings.

Contractor requirements for service

- a) The supply of the specified number of roadworthy 22 meter interlinks side tipper trucks for the provision of the service.

- d) Making available the Contracted Fleet and drivers for safety induction at Designated Loading and Offloading Points.

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- e) All trucks should have vehicle tracking devices installed.
- f) Ensuring that at all times the correct number of Contract Fleet Vehicles are in operation.
- g) Ensure that Eskom is notified immediately in writing of the intention to affect any change in the Contractor's Contract Fleet, including all vehicle details and fleet numbers and ensure that any additional Vehicles are fit for purpose and duly vetted and approved by Eskom.
