C4 SITE INFORMATION

GENERAL

This section describes the site at the time of tender to enable the tenderer to price their tender and to decide upon his method of working and programming and risks.

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SI 1 SITE INFORMATION

The mine site is approximately located at the coordinates 24°21'50.52"S and 30°17'3.03"E on the farm Streatham within the Greater Tubatse Local Municipality, approximately 45 kilometres from Burgersfort CBD and west of the Maretlwane village near the Penge Village within the Limpopo Province.

SI 2 SITE LOCATION

Figure 1 provides a locality map and shows the access route to site. Travel northeast from the CBD on R37 for 5.1km. Turn right onto road to Praktiseer and travel for 10km until you reach a four way stop. Turn left onto road D 2537 and travel for 28km. The site is on the left. The site can be easily accessed with a 4x2.

SI 3 EXISTING CONDITIONS

The surrounding area was previously rehabilitated. Land use of the surrounding environment is largely wilderness area with natural vegetation. The vegetation is fairly scattered to dense and consists of mostly shrubs on steep slopes.

SI 4 SERVICES AND EXISTING INFRASTRUCTURE

A direct access road is available and can be accessed with a 4x2. A passenger vehicle cannot drive into some sections due to overgrown vegetation. Potable water and electricity is not available on site.

The existing mining infrastructure to be demolished includes storage silos and operating buildings.
