The Crop Development Division at Bien Donne do not have a weed eater to cut the laws around the building, to control weeds around the buildings, on the pathways and access road. Tall weeds are also hosting snakes and could result in serious injuries. A lawnmower is not practical, since the ground level is not always level and access to smaller areas is restricting the use of a lawnmower.
