

ZWANE WELCOMES AMAZULU'S FIRST AWAY WIN

AmaZulu coach Arthur Zwane is a relieved man after his team registered their first away win in the current Betway Premiership season at the weekend.

Usuthu beat struggling Chippa United 3-0 at Buffalo City Stadium in East London on Saturday.

A brace by Hendrick Ekstein and another goal by Athini Mqokolo were enough to secure the visitors from Durban their first win on the road this season.

The win also moved AmaZulu to fifth on the PSL table. Zwane said the plan with the Eastern Cape trip had been to end their poor away record, adding he was happy they had achieved that.

"We came here with one thing in mind. We needed to change things in terms of us going away, we've been bad travelers," Zwane stated.

"This is our first game winning away from home. We've had opportunities

in the past. We actually had about three [opportunities] before this one, against Kaizer Chiefs, Sekhukhune and Magesi, where we scored first but allowed the opposition to come back and equalise.

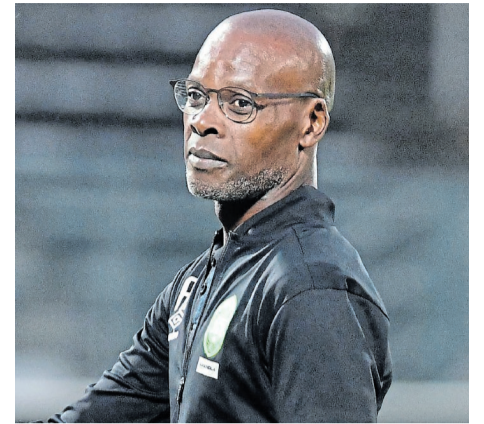
"So, we came into this game wanting to score first, [and] make sure that we don't concede. We started very slow, and in the space of 10 minutes, we could have conceded two goals. But that acted as a wake-up call for us and we started raising our game."

Usuthu will look to build on this win they host Polokwane City at Princess

Magogo Stadium tomorrow at 7.30pm.

"We still have a long way to go. We are still a work in progress. We will take one game at a time. We don't want to think about other things right now. We have another game on Tuesday and we need to make sure we are ready," he said.

"We defended better, but we could have done better in some areas of decision making in the middle of the park, trying to connect with our 10s as early as possible to create more scoring opportunities."
