9. Methodology: Monitoring must take place in the stream water habitat as well as the riparian zone.
 - Aquatic macro-invertebrates using the SASS method.
 - Physio-chemical measurements.
10. The appointed service provider will be required to work closely with Plantation management and the relevant environmental practitioner throughout the project. A person from the plantation may accompany the service provider.
11. The service provider must provide all materials and equipment to perform the task. (**Note:** Extensive use of gravel plantation roads required. Condition of roads, may vary from good to poor)
12. The service provider must include in their quotation, a feedback session to provide management and interested staff the outcome of the monitoring to improve awareness of the importance of water quality bio monitoring. The feedback session shall be in the form of a virtual presentation by using Microsoft Teams or a similar platform. The presentation is to be provided to Komatiland Forests.
13. The reports must be **finalised and provided** to Komatiland Forests in a user friendly format (Word / PDF) **before 29 March 2024**. The report should include the following:
 - ✓ Description of methodology.
 - ✓ An interpretation of the survey observations / results.
 - ✓ A clear set of recommendations for the future management and monitoring.
 - ✓ Any new information deemed applicable – visible site-specific anthropogenic impacts potentially affecting stream conditions negatively.
 - ✓ Photographic accounts should be included where applicable.

- (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
- (b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system,

then the organ of state must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for both the 80/20 preference point system.

Table 1: Specific goals for the tender and points claimed are indicated per the table below.
