

- 12.11 In the case of a joint venture, all partners (members) must include their SARS certificates/SARS PIN, proof of company address and a joint venture agreement. Parties to a joint venture should complete the following documents separately:

- 12.12 After the satisfactory delivery of services, payment will be made within 30 days after acceptance and receiving of a valid original tax invoice.
- 12.13 Supplier must give one week notice prior to deliver.
- 12.14 The bidder must demonstrate proven experience in the design, supply, installation and maintenance of integrated rural surveillance and smart monitoring systems. Such experience must be detailed on the experience form provided in the bid document.
- 12.16. The bidder must have a minimum of 5 years' experience in security surveillance technology or smart rural monitoring systems. Failure to attach proof of experience will result in your bid being disqualified.
- 12.17. The bidder must possess proven technical experience on long range surveillance, thermal surveillance, livestock tracking, geo-fencing, veld fire detection systems, vehicle registration recognition and central monitoring centre integration. Failure to attach evidence of technical experience will disqualify your bid.
- 12.18. The above technical experience must have been acquired through the successful completion of at least three (3) similar projects.
- 12.19. Proof of the above technical experience must be submitted in the form of appointment letters, completion certificates and reference letters with contactable references. Failure to attach this proof when submitting the bid document will result in your bid being disqualified.
- 12.20. The bidder must submit a recent bank rating letter stating positive rating to demonstrate capacity to deliver a project of this magnitude. Failure to attach this proof when submitting the bid document will result in your bid being disqualified.
- 12.21. The bidder must provide proof of equipment supply chain access, local technical support availability and spare parts availability within South Africa. Such proof must be submitted with this bid document.
- 12.22. The department may give preference to bidders who, have experience working in rural or farming communities, have implemented similar systems in high stock theft areas and can demonstrate understanding of rural safety challenges in Northern Cape conditions.
- 12.23. The Department reserves the right to request a live demonstration of the proposed technology, to conduct site visits to previously completed projects and verify references before awarding the bid. Therefore, failure to provide verifiable proof of experience will result in your being disqualified.
- 12.24 The winning bidder will be responsible for his/her insurance for duration of this project.
- 12.25 Lodging facilities will not be provided on project sites therefore the winning bidder will be responsible for his/her own accommodation and transportation.
- 12.26 The winning bidder must use existing water sources on the project sites; the winning bidder will not be allowed to create new water points without the approval of the property owner.
- 12.27 The winning bidder, his/her employees are not allowed to make any fire on the project sites for whatever reason.
