Thekwini TVET College invites tenders for the above mentioned project.

Prequalification: Only tenderers who meet the following prequalification criteria may respond:

Only tenderers who have the following are eligible to submit tenders/ proposals:

- proof of registration with the manufactory of the networking and electrical goods supplied,
- letter of good standing Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act (COIDA) or an application letter with a stamp from the Department of Labour,
- Only tenderers with a bank rating of A or B will be accepted

Tenders will be evaluated using the 80/20 principles of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, No. 5, 2000 with its 2017 Regulations and functionality – Organisational Capacity, Capabilities, and Experience in network cabling (40 Points), Locality of the bidder (20 Points), Bank rating (10 Points), Capacity and Experience of the team (30 Points). Proposals that fail to achieve a minimum score of 70% will not qualify for further evaluation.
