BACKGROUND

TCTA requires the services of a professional research company to design, administer and manage the organisation's culture survey. The request is for the customised survey to be administered to approximately 200 people. The design is to be completed in conjunction with OD personnel. The survey must be able to administer and retrieve submissions online. Expert data analysis using an automated system with multiple reporting required, including presentation of outcomes to EXCO, where applicable, based on outcomes.

SCOPE OF WORK

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF GOODS/SERVICES

The successful bidder will be required to:

Digital Culture Survey Solution

Requirements:

- Develop a digital culture survey solution linked to the current TCTA atmosphere. This should be a complete version (+/- 100 questions) of the current baseline questionnaire currently in use by TCTA.
- The survey must be able to identify and measure the key drivers of culture within TCTA.
- The service provider must provide analysis against the previous pulse and baseline surveys conducted over last 3 years and facilitate feedback presentations to EXCO.
- The service provider must provide a close-out report (The report must contain results, value-add recommendations, impact analysis of current TCTA practices vis-à-vis best practice, analysis against the previous pulse and baseline surveys conducted over last 3 years etc.), which contains organisational and divisional breakdowns of the analysis per question, as well improvement recommendations plus implementation plans per division and at organisational level.
- Bidders are encouraged to use specialised survey software and not the generic survey software such as MS Forms, Google Forms, Survey Monkey and others which are widely available on the internet.
- The survey solution must support:
 - Proven Advanced analytics: trend analysis, benchmarking against past surveys, divisional breakdowns.
 - Proven Custom reporting: automated dashboards and exportable reports.
 - Data security & compliance: alignment with POPIA.
 - Scalability: Proven ability to handle +/- 100 questions and large respondent groups.
 - Integration: Proven ability to compare with historical datasets (past 3 years).
