2.2. Exemption

Procurement of the service provider of a Fire Engineering consultant to redraw, design and/or rationalise the fire-fighting system, quantity material and equipment, engage the fire department for recommendation for approval, supervise the installation of the system to the municipal buildings etc.

The appointed Service provider shall be expected to:

- Physically re-measure and redraw the floor areas of the remaining twelve (12) buildings (i.e.libraries, community halls, landfill sites and sports complexes etc) of the Makhuduthamaga Local Municipality and indicate as per plans drawn
