- 9.3. It is the responsibility of the bidder to, when applicable, register with the Directorate Conventional Arms Control (DCAC), Defence Secretariat, in terms of section 13 of the National Conventional Arms Control Act and with the South African Council for the Non-Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction Act.
- 9.4 If a contract with Armscor is being entered into, the Contractor shall comply with arms control and non-proliferation requirements as prescribed by the contract.

This condition is also applicable to all contracts placed on a local company, subcontracting a single foreign company to the aforesaid value or more.



Culvert Dimensional Layout



CULVERT ARRAY FORMATION: OFFICE ENCLOSURE




Office Cubicle Dimensions



#### Annexure 3 ALKANTPAN Special Contract Conditions for the Construction of a test site at Alkantpan Test Range

#### 1 SPECIAL CONTRACT CONDITIONS

Special Requirements are negotiated technical and project management stipulations that will become contractually binding on the successful Bidder. These requirements are specific to an order and are over-and-above those prescribed in the bid documentation.

Special Requirements are distinct from critical criteria in that they do not contribute to the source selection decision. The Bidder must, however, supply the necessary proof as indicated per special requirement criterion.

It is to be noted that, although special requirement criteria do not contribute to the source selection process, non-compliance with some of the identified special requirement criteria may result in the inability to award the contract or the cancellation of the contract. Those specific criteria are clearly identified with Suspensive Clauses.

#### 1.1 Registration with the Compensation Commissioner.

#### Requirement:

The Bidder shall be registered with the Compensation Commissioner.

#### Motivation:

The Bidder is responsible for the registration of his / her personnel with the Compensation Commissioner and to provide his / her personnel with the necessary insurance. ATR has no liability toward the Compensation Commissioner for any deployed personnel of the Bidder and also has no liability with regard to the insurance of accidental cover toward the Bidder and / or his / her personnel. The Bidder indemnifies ATR against any such a liability.

#### Proof required:

The Bidder shall submit a valid and original or certified copy of the Letter of Good Standing with the Compensation Commissioner as prescribed by section 89 of the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act, 1993.

#### AND

The Bidder shall prepare and provide ATR with an indemnity statement, indemnifying ATR against any claim whatsoever in terms of insurance claims, covering the duration period of the contract upon placement of the contract.

#### Suspensive Clause:

No order can be placed on the Preferred Bidder if the Preferred Bidder did not supply a valid and original or certified copy of the Letter of Good Standing **and** the indemnity statement as specified above.





#### Annexure 3 Special Contract Conditions for the Construction of a test site at Alkantpan Test Range

Should the Preferred Bidder, within ten (10) days after notification, still not be in a position to supply ATR with a valid and original or certified copy of the valid and original Letter of Good Standing with the Compensation Commissioner and the indemnity statement as specified above the Preferred Bidder will be disqualified and the Bidder that scored the second best on Price and BEE evaluation will be identified as the Preferred Bidder.

#### 1.2 Public Insurance Liability

#### Requirement:

The Contractor shall, within 14 days after the signing the agreement, take out public liability insurance, at his own expense, to cover all his risks and liabilities in terms of the agreement.

#### Motivation:

The Bidder will be held responsible for damage or losses caused to third parties and / or damage to property by its personnel or representatives in any way sustained in connection with or by reasons of the execution of services.

It is the responsibility of the Bidder to provide for Public Insurance Liability.

#### Proof required

The Bidder shall supply ATR with written confirmation of the nature and period of the cover within 21 days after signing the agreement. Should the Bidder fail to do so, ATR reserves the right to take out the necessary insurance at the Bidder's expense.
