

ANNEXURE I – SUPPLIER DEVELOPMENT LOCALISATION & INDUSTRILIAZATION

Supplier Development & Localisation's mandate is to achieve maximum and sustainable local development impact through leveraging Eskom's procurement spend in a manner that allows flexibility within the business in order to accommodate government local development initiatives and policies. This shall be achieved by positively influencing the following: Local Content, Skills Development, Supplier Development, Job Creation and Industrialization.

Note: "Eskom reserves the right to award to a tenderer who may not be the highest scoring or highest ranked tenderer, in line with Section (2) (1) (f) of the PPPFA."

1) Prequalification

Tenderers shall have B-BBEE contributor level of between 1 and 4. A valid BBBEE certificate (issued by SANAS accredited Verification Agencies) or a signed & dated sworn affidavit for EMEs and QSEs should be submitted with the tender.

2) BBBEE

Tenderers' valid B-BBEE certificates shall be evaluated and allocated points in accordance with the B-BBEE Preferential Points Scorecard shown below:

3) Localisation

- a. The target for the local content of RMU shall be set at 30% of the contract amount.

4) Industrialisation

There is no specific target for industrialisation and the tenderers are requested to submit proposals.

5) Skills Development

Skills development shall have specific targets that address Eskom's core, scarce and critical skills and the SETA's scarce and critical skills. The target is a total of twenty four (24) candidates selected from all provinces as shown in Figure 2. The aim is to benefit the **currently unemployed** graduates from school; Technical, Vocational and Education (TVET) campuses; and universities.

The composition of these candidates must be representative of the population demographics of South Africa. Note that these targets for skills development candidates categorically exclude Eskom employees and registered learners. Tenderers shall develop the candidates directly in-house, through their supply network or through the SETA accredited training providers and the composition of the candidates shall be representative of the demographics of South Africa.

The purpose for skills development is to address the country's high unemployment rate by granting unemployed graduates with the necessary workplace experience and certification to be employable within the industry.

Note that the tenderers are responsible for carrying the total cost of developing these candidates, and Eskom shall not make any financial contributions towards the fulfillment of this obligation. In certain cases, the SETAs accredited training providers can be approached to participate in developing critical and scarce skills. The tenderers are advised to approach the relevant SETAs for grants, incentives and subsidies and also the South African Revenue Services for tax rebates which are made available to alleviate the skills development costs.

6) Jobs

The proposals from tenderers regarding number of jobs that will be created shall become contractual obligations. Tenderers shall also confirm the number of jobs retained as a direct result of these contracts. These figures shall be recorded in Figure 2.

7) Supplier Development

Supplier development: The tenderers are required to submit their plans for developing the capability and capacity of their Black Persons with Disability (BPwD); Black Youth Owned (BYO); Black Women Owned (BWO) and Black Owned (BO) subcontractors. These plans shall also contain detailed steps with milestones for the tenderers to improve their BBBEE contributor levels and to migrate to at least 51% black ownership.

8) Retention

a) Eskom shall be permitted to retain 2.5% (two and half percent) of the invoices (excluding VAT) as security for the fulfilment by the tenderers of their SDL&I obligations.

b) Once Eskom has verified that tenderers have fulfilled their SDL&I obligations, the 2.5% retained shall be approved for reimbursement by Eskom to suppliers within 90 (ninety) days of verification by Eskom.

9) Reporting

- a. The tenderers shall on a quarterly basis submit a report to Eskom in accordance with Data Collection Template on their compliance with the SDL&I obligations described above.
- b. Eskom shall review the quarterly reports submitted by the tenderers within 60 (sixty) days of receipt of the reports and notify the tenderers in writing if their SDL&I obligations have not been met.
- c. Upon notification by Eskom that the tenderers have not met their SDL&I obligations, the tenderers shall be required to implement corrective measures to meet those SD&L obligations before the commencement of the following quarter, failing which retention clauses shall be invoked.

Every contract shall be accompanied by the SDL&I implementation schedule which must be completed by the tenderers and returned to SDL&I representative for acceptance **before** contract award. This will be used as a reference document for monitoring, measuring and reporting on the tenderer's progress in delivering on their stated SDL&I commitments.
