Tender submissions must be properly bound and must be placed in the tender box situated on the ground floor of the uMgungundlovu District Municipality, 242 Langalibalele Street, Pietermaritzburg, before **12h00 on 11 September 2024** in a sealed envelope which is clearly marked with the Tender Number and Tender Description. Late quotations or Tenders received by way of Facsimile or E-Mail will under no circumstances be considered.

All eligibility criteria must be furnished accordingly, where, mandatory or applicable. Tenderers will thereafter be evaluated in terms of functionality. Tenderers that qualified in terms of the functionality criteria will then be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022.

- Bidders must complete and submit a declaration of proposed system Modules Functionality on pages
   45 to 46.
- Bidders must submit comprehensive product/system documentation of their respective proposed solutions.
- Bidders must submit a declaration of intent to collaborate with the Dube Trade Port Data Centre
   Corporation signed by both entities on page 47.

Tenderers will be evaluated in terms of functionality as part of the minimum requirements before evaluated on price and preference based on the following criteria:

A bidder/s that scores less than **75 points out of 100** in respect of functionality will be regarded as submitting a non-responsive bid and will be disqualified.
