Number	Clarification / Discussion
Q1	Bidders who will form a Joint Venture, can they submit letter to intent to form a Joint Venture and submit documents of the leading Partner at tender stage? Please confirm.
A1	<p>In the case of a joint venture bidders are required to submit information in the following manner:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Joint venture agreement stipulating the roles and responsibilities of each party in the JV • In terms of B-BBEE bidders are required to submit a joint valid B-BBEE certificate from a SANAS accredited Verification agency for the JV. JVs are not allowed to submit affidavits. • With respect to CIDB JVs are required to comply with the stipulated CIDB grading and class of works. Bidders may make use of the CIDB joint calculator to determine if they qualify for the required grading and class of works. Should the calculator indicate that the bidder is compliant, they may tender and submit the outcomes of the JV calculator together with the bid. • Tenderers must note that in the case of a joint venture or special purpose vehicle (SPV) especially formed for this tender, audited financial statements for each participant in the JV / SPV is required (refer to page 21 of the Invitation to Tender Document). • Details and confirmation of a single designated bank account in the name of the JV and independent of the individual JV partners, as set out in the joint venture agreement (refer to page 19 of the Invitation to Tender Document) • Both parties should submit their letters of good standing for OH&S requirements. • The other SHEQ documents should be for the party that we will be contracting with, that is, the JV and not the lead partner only.
