9.	<p>With reference to Request for Bid GT/GDE/014/2026 issued by the Gauteng Department of Education for the establishment of a pre-qualified list of service providers (CIDB Grades 3–6), we kindly seek clarification regarding the evaluation of key personnel.</p> <p>We would like to confirm whether we may utilise the qualifications and experience of one Construction Manager—who was previously submitted and evaluated under the GB/CE categories—for evaluation under the SQ category as well, provided that the Construction Manager has relevant and demonstrable experience in SQ, GB, and CE projects.</p> <p>The individual meets the required competency and has practical experience across these work categories. We therefore wish to confirm whether the same Construction Manager's credentials may be submitted for SQ evaluation in addition to GB/CE, or whether separate personnel are required per category.</p> <p>Your clarification in this regard will be highly appreciated to ensure compliance with the bid requirements.</p>	<p>Yes, Bidders are permitted to use 1(one) Construction Project Manager across multiple classes of work, provided that the Construction Project Manager is professionally registered with SACPCMP and meets the requirements stipulated in the tender document.</p>
