Re-Advertised REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS FOR RFQ FOR SERVICE
AND MAINTENANCE PLAN FOR NINE (9) ISUZU BAKKIES

1. Purpose

- 1.1. To invite service providers to send quotations for RFQ for Service and Maintenance Plan for Nine (9) Isuzu Bakkies

2. Considerations/background

- 2.1. The primary legislative mandate of the Railway Safety Regulator (RSR) is to oversee and enforce safety performance by all railway operators in South Africa, including those of neighbouring States whose rail operations enter South Africa.
- 2.2. The RSR has established four offices around the country and uses the offices as the operation base for its staff and for safekeeping of its assets, including vehicles.
- 2.3. The Facilities Management unit is responsible for procurement, managing, allocating, and coordinating the RSR fleet. As part of its assets, the RSR owns a fleet of 19 vehicles that are used on a day-to-day basis for official work.
- 2.4. The 19 vehicles are made up of nine (9) Isuzu double cab bakkies, two (2) Ford Ranger bakkies, one (1) Volkswagen minibus, one (1) Isuzu SUV, and six (6) sedans, procured through the RT57 contract, with the first batch of vehicles delivered in 2019.
- 2.5. As part of the above fleet, there are nine (9) Isuzu double cab bakkies allocated to the four (4) RSR offices, which were purchased through RT57 contract in 2019, meaning that the vehicles are now six (6) years old. The vehicles came with a standard three (3) year or 120,000 KM maintenance plan or whichever comes first.
- 2.6. The vehicles are serviced every 15 000Km or 12 months or whichever occurs first.
- 2.7. In the year 2023, we were able to purchase an additional two (2) years' service and

maintenance plan through Isuzu SA, the additional plan was meant for two (2) service intervals/ two (2) years which was 2024 and 2005.

- 2.8. As per the Isuzu SA's maintenance plan, we have been informed that an extended service and maintenance plan can only be extended once after the standard plan has lapsed, Which the RSR has already extended and therefore exhausted the extension.
- 2.9. The vehicles are still in good condition, roadworthy, and safe to drive. Based on the overall condition and mileage, the RSR has decided to keep the vehicles for a few more years. The vehicles mileages are still below 90 000 km.

3. Scope of work / Specification

Specifications are as follows: RFQ for Service and Maintenance Plan for Nine (9) Isuzu Bakkies

- 3.1. The RSR is seeking the services of a provider who can service and maintain the nine (9) Isuzu double cab bakkies through a certified Isuzu network, which will be able to provide full-service records with the original manufacture's equipment certificates and warranty on parts.
- 3.2. The appointed service provider should be able to use the national network of the Isuzu SA, as the vehicles are allocated to different RSR offices in the country.
- 3.3. The service and maintenance plan is for the next two (2) service intervals (15 00KM interval) or next two (2) years which is 2026 and 2027 whichever occurs first.

4. Administrative / Compliance Requirements

- 4.1. Registration on National Treasury CSD report
- 4.2. Comprehensive quotation (prices must be VAT Inclusive)
- 4.3. Tax Pin & Tax clearance certificate
- 4.4. Fully Completed and signed Standard Bidding Documents (SBD) forms documents
- 4.5. A valid BBBEE certificate or sworn affidavit (on sworn affidavit indicate the day, month and year of the financial year period ie, 31 March 2022)
- 4.6. Valid company registration documentation that are issued by Companies & Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC)
- 4.7. A Copy of the identity document of the company owner(s)
- 4.8. Valid Medical Certificate
- 4.9. Valid South African Social Security Agency (SASSA) registration (**Where applicable**)
- 4.10. Valid National Council for Persons with Physical Disability in South Africa registration (NCPDPSA)

Failure to submit valid documents listed above (No - 4.5, 4.6, 4.7, 4.8, 4.9, 4.10) for proof of claim specific goals as stipulated in Section 6 below will lead to the service provider not being awarded points for specific goal.

5. Evaluation 80/20 Preference Point System

- 5.1. The price quotations will be evaluated in accordance with the pre-scripts of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) and its regulations, in particular Preference Procurement Regulation 2022 which stipulate **80/20 preference point system for acquisition of goods or services**

with Rand value equal to or below R50 million (inclusive of all applicable tax).

5.2. A maximum of 80 points for price and 20 points for the specific goal specified on the request for quotation may be awarded to a Service Provider.

5.3. Points for the specific goal will be awarded as specified on the table below:
