Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd (hereinafter "Eskom") invites you to submit a tender provision for the provision of Vegetation Management Service (Grass cutting, Reeds cutting, Bush clearing and Tree felling and herbicide application) in Transmission Northern Grid Powerlines and HV Plant Substations for a period of five (05) years on an as and when required basis. The enquiry documents are supplied to you Free of charge.

Eskom has delegated the responsibility for this tender to the Eskom *Representative* whose name and contact details are set out in the Tender Data. A submission of a tender by you in response to this *Invitation* will be deemed as your acceptance of the Eskom Standard Conditions of Tender (to be accessed via <a href="https://www.eskom.co.za">www.eskom.co.za</a>).

Tenderers must refrain from communicating issues related to this tender with any person within the Eskom environment other than the Eskom *Representative* named in the RFP during the tender process. Tenderers must not in any way contact any Eskom employee who is involved in the tender during the tender process, either telephonically, by email or through private appointments before and after submitting tenders. Eskom employees not involved in this tender are not allowed to contact employees involved in this tender or provide information about the tender to potential tenderers.

Where a potential tenderer or a tenderer has any question or query on the contents of the tender or any issue related to the tender, the first point of contact is the Eskom *Representative* whose name and contact details are stated in the tender document.

Should the tenderer not be satisfied with a response from the Eskom *Representative* stated in the tender document, and would like to escalate, the tenderer may refer the issue to the Procurement Manager identified in the letter of invitation through the buyer. Should the tenderer still be dissatisfied, it can then escalate the matter to the Middle Manager or Senior Manager Procurement.

To claim preference points as specific goals/preference points, a tenderer must submit the following documentation:

- Valid B-BBEE certificate issued by a B-BBEE verification professional/ a sworn affidavit/CIPC affidavit.
- Proof of ownership/ shareholding (preferably CIPC documentation) inclusive of shareholding breakdown,
- Certified ID copies of shareholder(s)
- Proof of Disability (where applicable).

A tenderer failing to provide documentation for the allocation of preference points will not be disqualified, but-

- a) may only score points out of 80 for price
- b) scores 0 points out of 20 for specific goals.

A tenderer may not be awarded points for specific goals/preference points if the tender documents indicate that the tenderer intends to subcontract more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other person not qualifying for at least the points that the tenderer qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME that can execute the subcontract.

NOTE: Failure on the part of the supplier to submit supporting documents/proof of specific goals for purposes of evaluation and scoring by Tender closing will not result in disqualification (if tenderer is otherwise deemed to be responsive/acceptable in all other aspects). The tenderer will, however, be scored zero for Specific goals for purposes of PPPFA scoring and ranking.

# 3.18 Ranking of tenders

# PPPFA Price and Preference Points

Suppliers will be ranked based on their scores as per PPPFA scoring:

- as standard rates are applicable, and it is a mandatory requirement for contractors to accept these rates all contractors that qualify will be awarded 80 points.
- contractors will then receive the points for B-BBEE will be awarded out of 20 points.

Eskom will then add the score from Pricing and Specific goals together and rank the suppliers from the highest to the lowest.

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Should there be 2 or more suppliers with equal score, the following criteria for breaking the deadlock in scoring will be applied:

- If two or more tenderers score an equal total number of points, the contract must be awarded to the tenderer that scored the highest points for specific goals.
- •If two or more tenderers score equal total points in all respects, the award must be decided by the drawing of lots.

# The process of drawing lots will be as follows:

- a) The CFT to gather in a venue where the lot will be drawn, and attendance register must be signed.
- b) The relevant procurement practitioner will write the names of the tenderers on pieces of paper of the same size, shape and colour.
- c) The Procurement Manager will verify that the process was followed in accordance with the aforesaid requirements.
- d) An independent person (from the procurement transaction and from P&SCM and End-user departments) will draw the lot/s. The independent person will read out the name/s of the successful tenderer/s. Where available, it is recommended that the auditor, who audits the process, draws the lots.
- e) This process must be recorded by the Procurement Practitioner and the minutes must be accepted in writing by the CFT and acceptance of the minutes must be sent to the Procurement Practitioner for record keeping.

# No of suppliers required for the Vegetation Management tender

A total of thirty (30) Suppliers will be appointed after the evaluation process and Eskom will enter into contracts with the suppliers to render vegetation management services for the Northern Grid for a period of five (5) years on an as and when required basis. The thirty (30) Suppliers will be split up as follows:

- Limpopo Section 20 suppliers
- North-West Section 10 suppliers

**NB:** Tenderers are required to indicate with their tender submission the Section of the Grid they are tendering for, namely: Limpopo Section or North-West Section.

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	A tenderer that has tendered for both Sections and is successful in both, can only be awarded a tender for one region. No tenderer will be awarded contracts for both Sections. Tenderers who tender for both Sections must indicate their preferred section in the event that they are successful in both sections.  Allocation of work in the section  Suppliers appointed out of this tender process will be required to be available for work on any of the sites in the sections for the duration of the contract. Work will be allocated to suppliers on a rotational basis with no specific preference for site. Failure to do so may result in the supplier's offer(s) being disqualified.
