TRANSFER OF CONTRACTS FROM ESKOM HOLDINGS SOC LTD (“ESKOM”) RELATING TO ITS TRANSMISSION DIVISION) TO THE NATIONAL TRANSMISSION COMPANY SOUTH AFRICA SOC LTD (“NTCSA”) BY OPERATION OF LAW

In accordance with the roadmap issued by the Department of Public Enterprises and the requirements of the Companies Act, 2008 (the “Act”), Eskom, having obtained the necessary consents required in terms of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (“PFMA”), formed a wholly owned subsidiary, NTCSA, during 2021 for the purposes of acquiring the Transmission Business conducted by Eskom as a separate division (the “Business”) from Eskom pursuant to a statutory merger under the Act (the “Merger”). Eskom and NTCSA entered into a merger agreement as required by the Act in order to implement the Merger. Once implemented, the Merger will result in NTCSA becoming the sole owner of the Business including all its assets and NTCSA becoming liable for all the obligations of Eskom as regards the Business by operation of law pursuant to sections 113, 115 and 116 of the Act.

The Merger will be implemented on 1st July 2024 from when NTCSA will start trading as a wholly owned subsidiary of Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd. All contracts which you as a counterparty concluded with Transmission Division of Eskom relating to the Business will be transferred by operation of law to NTCSA on 1 July 2024. From that date you will no longer deal with Eskom but NTCSA as regards the Transmission Business, including existing contracts. Please note that contracts with other Eskom Divisions will not be affected by the Merger and those Eskom Divisions will continue to be counterparties for their respective contracts.

The terms of the transferred contracts will not be affected by the Merger but will remain unchanged.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of the details of NTCSA which you should use from 1 July 2024, for all current procurement related transactions concluded between your company and the Transmission Division of Eskom.

All invoices issued after 1 July 2024 should be addressed to the National Transmission Company South Africa as follows:

Until 30 September 2024, notices and correspondence should be sent to the current Eskom email address as well as the new NTCSA email address to [the same individual]. From 1 October 2024, notices should only be sent to the NTCSA email address. For example:
