 - place an order in connection with this Quotation at any time after the RFQ's closing date;
 - award only a portion of the proposed goods / services which are reflected in the scope of this RFQ;

- 1. Service provider should be able to deliver training using face-to-face and Instructor led Virtual learning based on the Human Change Management Body of Knowledge (**HCMBOK**).
- 2. Service Provider to provide **(HCMBOK)** training and certification for 60 Change Management Professionals and Project Managers across Transnet Freight Rail within a (12) month period
- 3. The training should provide a solid understanding of the methodology, tools, good practices and tactics for managing the human factor in change processes.
- 4. After completion practitioners should be able to understand and differentiate human behaviours in the face of a changing situation and manage the human factor throughout the project and in its sustaining phase
- 5. The training should be aimed at developing employee knowledge and skills in human change management.
- 6. The training is required to provide practitioners with skills to reduce organizational hostility and enhance employee engagement.
- 7. Improve the ability to achieve organization's strategic goals.
- 8. To provide an understanding of strategic change management standards.
- 9. Training to provide insight into how practitioners can manage the change factor in the change process.
- 10. Ability to understand human behavior, resilience management and stakeholder relationships in the change process.
- 11. To enable practitioners to analyze the logical and psychological conflicts connected with discomfort promoted by change.
- 12. Effectively coordinate change agents.
- 13. To enable practitioners and project managers to apply different stakeholder management techniques.

14. Service Provider will use Transnet facilities for conducting training

9. Resources Required

- Service Provider to have HCMBOK certified trainers
- Service provider to provide training and (HCMBOK) certification across all identified change practitioners and project managers across Transnet Freight Rail
- Service Provider certificate from an Association of Change Management Practitioners' Qualified Education Provider.
- Service Provider to provide progress requests as and when required

10. TERMS

 This service required is for the period of 24 months and shall commence as indicated in the letter of acceptance

11. REQUIREMENTS

- Service provider should be certified/licensed by Human Change Management Institute to provide accredited HCMBOK training
- Service provider should have a minimum of 5 years' experience providing change management training
- Service provider needs to submit a proposal indicating Monthly reporting of program delivery and progress
- Training should have both face-to-face and virtual instructor led options

12. Legal review

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business.

13. Security clearance

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the goods and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

14. National Treasury's Central Supplier Database


