# 1. Background

uMngeni-uThukela Water Laboratory is responsible for water quality monitoring. The role of the Laboratory includes receiving of water sample, their analysis and production of water quality results. Samples are collected by one of Water Quality division called Sampling Services and delivered into the Laboratory for different method analysis. One of the tests that are carried out in the Microbiology Laboratory require filtration of the samples using a manifold membrane filtration. This includes test such as the analysis of *V. cholerae*, Salmonellae and *Clostridium pefrigens*.
