Bidders are advised not to commit fraudulent activities or forged documents. All abusers of the SCM system, including or faking of returnable documents may be reported to the SAPS and may restricted from doing business with any public institution for a period not exceeding 10 years as in line with sections 28 and 29 of the prevention and combating of corrupt activities Act 12 of 2004.

A preferential system shall apply whereby this contract will be allocated to bidder in accordance with the preferential procurement policy framework Act no. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the bid document, read in conjunction with the preferential procurement regulation of 2022 where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of targeted goals respectively.

Completed Bid documents must be deposited on/before 12H00 on 19/02/2025 on the tender box placed at the main entrance of the municipality (Civic Centre), 9 Park Street Malelane 1320.

Tender/bid documentation must be submitted in a sealed envelope or container on which the tender/bid number and addresses are clearly marked. No tenders /bids transmitted by fax or E-mail will be accepted. It must be noted that the municipality is not bound to accept the lowest on any other tender. Tenders/Bids which is incomplete or filled incorrectly, not filled in the official bid documentation or which is received after the close of the bids will be ignored.
