Tenders are hereby invited for the **Upgrading of the George New Water Treatment Works (20ML) Civil Extension.**

Tenders may only be submitted on the Tender documentation that is issued.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of Tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

**Tender No. T/ING/020/2021** must be placed in the tender box at the George Municipality on the **First Floor, Directorate: Financial Services, Supply Chain Management, York Street, George** by no later than **12:00 on Tuesday, 30 November 2021**. Tenders will be opened on the same day in the Committee Room at 12:05. Late or unmarked Tenders will not be considered. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late Tenders will not be accepted.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will be held at **10:00 on Tuesday, 2 November 2021 via Microsoft Teams**. Tenderers must register per e-mail at Mr Marc Jacobs with e-mail address [mcjacobs@george.gov.za](mailto:mcjacobs@george.gov.za) **before 10:00 on Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021** in order to receive an invite for the compulsory meeting.

The information session site visit details will be finalized during the Microsoft Teams Meeting. If tenderers do not register for attendance before **10:00 on Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021** with Mr Marc Jacobs; tenderers will not be able to attend the compulsory Information session and will invalidate your tender.

Bidders should be represented at the compulsory clarification meeting and site inspection by **a technical employee from the prospective bidder** who is suitably qualified and experienced to comprehend the implications of the work involved.

The certificate of attendance will only be signed after the site inspection.

#### Tender criteria:

Bidders must be registered with the CIDB and it is estimated that Bidders should have a grading designation of **8CE** or as per the minimum threshold requirement.

Sub-Contractors:

- 30% of the scope of work must be subcontracted.

The following components of the scope must be subcontracted to Subcontractor with a stipulated minimum B-BBEE status level of level 3:

- Roofing labour;
- Paving;
- Fencing;
- Fixing of reinforcement;
- Brickwork;
- Pipe line.

Prospective Bidders must note that the local production and content requirements for designated sectors, as stipulated in the Preferential Procurement Regulations made in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 5 of 2000, will apply to this tender, for the following products:

- Electrical and telecom cables – 90%
- Valve products and actuators – 70%
- Conveyance pipes – 80 to 100%
- Steel products and components for construction – 100%
- Pump, medium voltage motors and associated accessories – 70 to 100%
- Designated Hardware Components (bolts, washers, etc.) – 100%
- Steel pipe fittings and specials – 80 to 100%

All bidders must complete the MBD6.2 form and Annexures C, D and E in this tender for the above products. Bids that does not comply with this requirement will not be considered for evaluation.

Tenders will be evaluated as follows:

Stage 1: Functionality

Only Tenders scoring a minimum of **110 out of 150** points in stage 1 for experience gained in **Civil Works associated with refurbishment/upgrading of Water and Wastewater Treatment Works and the construction of water retaining concrete at Water/Wastewater Treatment Works** will be considered further for evaluation in stage 2.

Stage 2:

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudication in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000) Regulations 2017 and the George Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy, where **90** points will be scored for price and **10** points for B-BBEE status.
