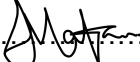

The supplier shall be required to provide samples of some of the proposed Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and workwear items for evaluation prior to bulk manufacture and delivery. The PPE items listed in Part B shall meet the standard and quality requirements of the PPE currently in use at Eskom, as outlined in PPE Standard 240-44175132. All products shall comply with the applicable SABS/SANS standards and approval requirements, where applicable, and shall incorporate the specified Eskom-branded colours and Eskom logo in accordance with the Employer's requirements.

The samples to be submitted by the supplier shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
