1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this RFQ is to invite a consultant to review, analyse and reconcile the information received via the request for information issued for the SANParks fuel tender.

2. BACKGROUND

South African National Parks (SANParks) is a public entity functioning under National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act 57 of 2003 (Act 57 of 2003); with the mandate to conserve; protect; control; and manage national parks and other defined protected areas and their biological diversity (Biodiversity). As a public entity, SANParks is also governed by the Public Finance Management Act, Act 1 of 1999 (as amended by Act 29 of 1999), and it is listed as Schedule 3 Part A: public entities.

SANParks' operations are totally guided by its vision statement and mission statement. As a public entity, the organisation is committed to act in pursuance of transformation of South Africa's society in support of entrenching South Africa's democracy. In this regard, the organisation has adopted a transformation mission to guide its efforts accordingly.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

SANParks needs the consultant to perform the following tasks:

- Review the information received
- Reconcile all information received.
- Analyse the received information and write an outcome report
- Advise SANParks on best practices in the fuel industry.
- Write up a report on the possible options available for SANParks in improving and maintaining the fuel infrastructure within the organisation.
- Assist SANParks with the compilation of a tender document for the supply of fuel and upgrade of fuel related infrastructure in different locations within SANParks.
- All information reviewed and analysed during the time of the assigned project remains the intellectual property of SANParks.
- Documents to always remain on SANParks premises (Kruger National Park). If removed responsibility of safe keeping will be transferred to the successful bidder from SANParks.

Requirements:

- 10 years consulting experience within the petroleum industry.
- 5 years minimum technical experience within the petroleum industry.
- Have a engineer with a minimum 5 years' experience in the petroleum industry on staff for this project.
