SPECIFICATION/DETAILS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. SCOPE:

Quotations are hereby invited for the purchasing of all the Municipality's available empty cable reels at all the stores where cable reels are generated in the City of Tshwane, over a period of one (1) year.

2. QUANTITY:

The successful tenderer will be required to collect whatever quantity is available on a monthly basis or when called upon to do so.

3. COLLECTION:

The cable reels must be removed within one (1) week after having being advised by the Municipal Official.

4. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The bid will be evaluated in two stages. The evaluation will be done as follows:

Stage 1: Administrative requirements

All the proposals will be evaluated against the Administrative responsiveness requirements as set out in the list of returnable documents.

Stage 2: Preferential Point System

The preferential points to be used will be the 80/20 points system in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act 5 of 2000) Regulations 2022.

- 80 points for price
- 20 points for specific goals
 - Bidders are required to submit supporting documents for their bids to claim the specific goal points.
 - Non-compliance with specific goals will not lead to disqualification but bidders will not be allocated specific goal points. Bidders will score points out of 80 for price only and zero (0) points out of 20 for specific goals.

 Cot shall act against any bidder or person when it detects that the specific goals were claimed or obtained on a fraudulent basis.

The specific goal for this bid is outlined below. Bidders are to submit supporting documents as outlined below to be eligible for points.

5. VALIDITY PERIOD

The validity period for the tender after closure is 90 days. CoT shall have right and power to extent any tender validity period beyond any initial validity period set and subsequent extensions.

SCM shall ensure that an extension of validity is requested in writing

from all bidders before the validity expiry date. Extension of validity shall be finalized while the quotations/bids are still valid.

7. **CONDITIONS OF SALE**:

- 7.1 The cable reels sites may be inspected by arrangement with Me Magda Van Zyl at the Municipality's Disposal Store at 31 Von Wielligh Street, Pretoria West. Tel 012 358 6717, between the hours of 08H00 to 15H00 on Mondays to Fridays.
- 7.2 The successful tenderer shall remove the items at his/their own expense.
- 7.3 Offers must be submitted on the attached Form of Tender and Form of Acceptance, Form B that must be completed in every particular and be signed.
- 7.4 The successful tenderer shall, immediately on acceptance of his/her tender, deposit a sum of R10, 000-00 to the Chief Creditors Section, which amount will be required in cash or a bank guaranteed cheque.
 - 7.4.1 The Chief Creditors will issue a receipt for the full amount.
 - 7.4.2 When cable reels is collected, the receipt must be presented to the Storekeeper in charge.
 - 7.4.3 The cable reels must be removed from the sites within seven (7) days from the date of notification, but in no case shall the cable reels be removed before sufficient funds are available on the tenderers credit worthy sheet at the offices of the Disposal Store, attention Lynette Greyling (telephone number 012 358 6707) at 31 Von Wielligh Street, Pretoria West.
 - 7.4.4 The total value of the cable reels collected will in each case be deducted from the deposit of R10, 000-00. The total value of the cable reels collected may not exceed the deposit received. If the deposit amount is exceeded, the further collection of cable reels will only be allowed once payment of an additional deposit of R10, 000-00 to the Chief Creditors section is received.
 - 7.4.5 After the expiry of the contract the credit balance of the deposit amount will be refunded.
 - 7.4.6 When collecting cable reels the successful tenderer will be required to sign the Delivery note for cable reels received.
- 7.5 If any dispute of difference should arise between the tenderer and the Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality, concerning the sale of the cable reels, such dispute or difference shall be referred to the Municipal Manager whose decision is final and binding on all parties, without appeal.
- 7.6 Any damage to Municipal property during the removal of the items shall be making good by the Municipality at the contractor's expense. Therefore, contractors are advised to take out suitable insurance to cover such damages.
- 7.7 From the date of acceptance of the tender, as referred to in Clause 5.5.3, the items will remain on site entirely on the purchaser's risk, and not removed within the time stipulated in Clause 5.5.3, the Municipality reserves the right to dispose

of the items after having given fourteen (14) days notice to the purchaser concerned. Any loss sustained by the Municipality through so disposing of the items shall be borne by the aforesaid tenderer and if necessary shall be recoverable by legal process.

7.8 The tenderer will not be permitted to dismantle and/or sort any item/s on the Municipality's premises prior to or during the loading/removal process.
