The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably qualified and experienced contractor for the construction of Ward 13 Community Hall. . **Only tenderers with minimum CIDB grading of 5GB or higher and who are B-BBEE Level 1 and 2 contributors will be considered for the appointment.**

Interested tenderers are required to submit a Bidder Registration Form, which is available on the Municipality's website www.msunduzi.gov.za in the Tenders Folder. The registration will start from **Thursday, 02 September 2021** until **Thursday, 09 September 2021** at **12h00**.

No tender registration will be considered after the above closing date and time for registration. Tenderers who fail to register within the registration period will not be eligible to receive tender document and to submit their respective tender documents when the tender closes.

Tenders must be submitted both in hard copy and on CD/USB flash Drive contained in sealed envelopes and marked with "Contract No. SCM 12 OF 21/22" with the Contract Description must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 Thursday, 07 October 2021**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 80/20 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-
