SCOPE OF WORK

Purchase, collection and disposal of various scrapped ferrous metal (CT/VTs, Glass and/or Ceramic Insulators, Reclosers/Breakers, Isolators, Steel Cages, Porcelain, Steel, Sub-Grade, Line Hardware and anything that falls within the ferrous commodities) at Eskom Gx Matimba Power Station on "as and when" required basis for a period of 36 months from the date of contract signature.

The successful contractors will be required to comply with the below contract obligation:

- The contract will be valid for thirty-six (36) months duration, although this is contractual and fixed there will be work instruction / task orders issued per site that will be required to actioned and completed by the successful tenderer within 7 working days of issue. Each work instruction / task order is a standalone task order.
- The successful supplier will be required to take all removable ferrous scrap metals and thereafter submit weighbridge slip to site supervisor and subsequently email it to the Investment Recovery Officer together with the proof of payment. Payment Price will be invoiced on the Monthly ITAC Metal Bulletin price as per the offer percentage.
- The successful tenderer will be required to weigh the truck empty and once loaded weigh the truck full.

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- Material must be weighed at the power station or public weighbridge which is not more than 20km radius from site and not on the supplier's premises and will be for the account of the Purchaser. The weighbridge facility must be acceptable for Eskom.
- Eskom employee or security to accompany truck to the weighbridge to witness the weighing and to get weighbridge slip for every collection.
- All aluminium/copper conductor or aluminium/copper conductor off cuts whether on any salvageable item or not shall remain the property of Eskom at all times. Where the bulk of the material may have to be reworked, stripped or processed away from Eskom premises, then the aluminium/copper conductor and off cuts must be returned to Eskom. NOTES

- a. Eskom will not be responsible for any damages or losses suffered during the removal of the oil incurred while working on this project arising from theft, damage or personal injury.
- b. You will be required to adhere to the condition as laid out by the Eskom site agent with regards to site access etc.
- c. Littering is prohibited at all times. Facilities will have to be made available on site during dismantling operations for the collection of disposal waste material. No rubble whatsoever is to be left on site.
- d. Additional precautions must be taken when using cutting equipment. Portable fire fighting equipment must be available on site during all stages of the work programme.
- e. The SCRAP OIL is sold with unknown quantity, unless specifically mentioned of oil but any oil remaining in the equipment shall become the property of successful tenderer and the tenderer will be responsible for any oil spillage.
- f. The successful tenderer will be required to be obtain an Eskom permit, prior to commencement of work. After completion of the work, it is imperative that you notify the Eskom site agent, so that the job can be signed off.

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
