Bid are to be completed in accordance with the conditions attached to the Bid document and must be sealed in an envelope and marked: **"BID NO.: 02/25/26 Suitably Qualified And Experienced Service Provider establish temporary pound and Render Animal Pound Services For Thirty-Six (36) months in terms of the Kwazulu-Natal Pound Act (Act No.03 Of 2006)"** and must be deposited in the tender box situated at the reception: Civic Centre, 2 Kingfisher Road, Mandeni **no later than 12h00, on Friday, 27th February 2026** at which time bids will be opened in public. Closing time will **only** be determined by the Municipal watch displayed on the Municipal wall at the reception.
