Tenders will be evaluated using Administrative Compliant, Functionality and the 80/20 principles of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, No. 5, 2000 with its 2017 Regulations. Only tenderers meet minimum qualifying score of **(70%)** on functionality as detailed in the tender document shall qualify for further evaluation.
