CLOSING DATE (AT 11:00): Thursday, 14 December 2023.

The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) invites tenders for the provision of the New Interchange on National Route 2 Section 11 km 66.75 at Colchester. This project is in the province of the Eastern Cape and in the metropolitan municipality of Nelson Mandela Bay and the approximate programme is for design and construction documentation to be completed by May 2026, followed by supervision of 22 months, commencing March 2027.

Only tenderers who are registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database and meet the minimum requirements for the key persons as stipulated in Clause C.2.1 at the tender closing date, are eligible to tender

Joint Ventures (JV) will be allowed on condition that one JV partner is a Targeted Enterprise. The JV partner will, however, not contribute to sub-contract target for Targeted Enterprises.
