If you don't have, please you can go and gather information, but bear in mind that the information that you will be submitting through to the banks will be verified and the due diligent will be performed. And we also would like to indicate to the bidders, if you are a director of different companies, you are not allowed to submit proposal for the different companies that you are registered for. You can only respond as one company. If you have multiple companies, you cannot submit multiple submissions. You can only select one company that you will be responding for.
