

Contract Manager: Contract Manager must at least have a post matric minimum qualification (NQF level 6 or SAQA equivalency certificate for international qualification). Have a minimum of 3 (three) years' relevant work experience relating to contract management related field in water and sanitation or similar nature projects. Common Errors by Tenderers

- Submitting incomplete returnable schedules
- Submitting an incorrect CV for required Personnel
- Submitting an incorrect qualification for required Personnel
- Track Record not clear in meeting requirements
- Failure to adhere to tender pricing instructions
- Making assumptions instead of seeking clarity
