- 1.2 Grand total of bid price must be indicated on the relevant **SBD 3.1 form** unless otherwise requested by the Department.
- 1.3 The pricing schedule must be completed in pen ink. Failure to do so will invalidate your offer.
- 1.4 Grand total price indicated on the SBD 3.1 form must correspond with the total price indicated on the pricing schedule.
- 1.5 Service provider must ensure correct calculations as the department will not take responsibility for incorrect prices.

### 2. COMPLETION AND SUBMITTING OF BID DOCUMENT

### A. STANDARD BID DOCUMENTATION FORMS (SBD) TO BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED

### 2.1 SBD 1:

### 2.2 SBD 4:

### 2.4 SBD 6.1:

### 7. PHASE 3: EVALUATION ON PRICE AND PREFERENCE (80/20 preference point system)

7.1 Bids will be evaluated in terms of the new Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2017 Regulation 3(a)(ii) "if it is unclear which preference point system will be applicable, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system.

- 7.4 Bidders must ensure that the B-BBEE status level verification certificates submitted are isssued by the following agencies:
