1. Welcome and Opening

The chairperson welcomed everyone.

2. Safety and Emergency Evacuation Procedure

3. Declaration of Interest

No conflict of interest was recorded.

4. Commercial Requirements by Tisetso Mokoena.

- Tender number E2690DXNCOU, please make sure that the tender no is labelled correctly.
- Tender closing date: 29 April 2026 at 10h00.
- Tender Extension Closing date: 22 May at 10h00.
- Tenderers are required to submit their bids online. Kindly familiarize yourself with the system to avoid technical failure at closing date. <https://etendering.eskom.co.za>
- Tender validity: 120 days
- Eskom intends to award single or multiple tenderers. For multiple awards, one supplier will be awarded for various sites in the Northern Cape and the other will be awarded on the North-West sites. In the case of single award, the supplier will be responsible for both sites.
- Eskom reserves the right to enter into negotiations with the supplier if the prices are not market related.
- The tender will be evaluated on the 80/20 principle.

- Tenderers are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the content of the invitation to tender.
 - Tenderers (whether a single company or an incorporated or unincorporated joint venture or consortium) must meet the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Data. The tenderer, or any of its principals, must not be under any restriction to do business with Eskom or State-Owned Companies.
 - Eskom has populated CPA breakdown, please refer to the ITT, suppliers are also allowed to propose if they are using another index.
 - Service Providers are required to familiarize themselves with the NEC and note any deviation, we can be in discussion during Negotiations
- If tenderers are submitted a sworn affidavit, it must be properly completed. B-BBEE certificate must be signed by the Commissioner of Oaths

Questions and Answers:

Question: Suppliers has expressed dissatisfaction with Eskom not responding to questions and only publishing the Q&A a day before tender closing.

Answer: Reassuring the suppliers that we will respond as soon as possible and committed to publish those Q&A within 24 hours.

Question: If Eskom is intending to award for 2 suppliers (Northern Cape & North-West Operating Unit), how is Eskom going to award this?

Answer: This will be in line with the PPPFA.

5. Scope of Work.

The scope of work and technical evaluation was presented by Mr. Gilbert Kok.

NB: Failure to submit the mandatory requirements will result in disqualification.

Question: On the gatekeeper, Eskom reference that the technicians must have been registered as Grade B? And according to the Legislation and Psira standards, a technician can be registered and perform their duties on Grade E & D. the Grade B is usually the director or management, definitely not technicians.

Answer: The Grade B for technicians is required when they need to work alone on sites. However, Grade C or D can be submitted but on a condition that the technician will work under the supervision of someone who has a Grade B, failure to adhere to this condition, Eskom reserves the right to terminate the contract.

Question: No OEM accreditation is mentioned on the listed security technologies systems.

Answer: Suppliers are expected to submit the OEM accreditation relating to Avigilon VMS, Gallagher ACS, Fingerprint readers and proxy readers and scanners, Axis CCTV cameras and Videofied.

Question: No Bill of Quantity is attached.

Answer: Tisetso checked if indeed the Bill of Quantity is not attached. And confirmed that only on Eskom bulletin is not attached. And reassure the supplier that it will be uploaded.

Question: The presented Bill of Quantity does not include the access control pricing and other more materials that are in line with the scope of work? How does the service providers then do justice to the pricing?

Answer: Eskom will relook at the Bill of Quantity and revised it. Suppliers must be on the lookout for a revised Bill of Quantity.
