PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT
BIDDERS WHO DO NOT MEET THE PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA BELOW, WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND
WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FURTHER IN THE EVALUATION PROCESS:

# Bidders must submit a level 1 or 2 B-BBEE Status Level Status.

- Bidders who do NOT qualify as Exempted Micro Enterprises (EME's) or Qualifying Small Enterprises
  (QSE's) must submit B-BBEE verification certificates which have been prepared by an agency that is
  accredited by SANAS (South African National Accreditation System).
- In the case of Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSE), if the bidding entity is more than 51% black owned, then no B-BBEE certificate is required as an affidavit signed by the QSE representative and attested by a commissioner of oaths will be sufficient.
- If the QSE is less than 51% black owned, then the bidding entity will be required to provide an original and valid B-BBEE Certificate or certified copies thereof indicating its compliance level as either a level 1 or 2 (as the case may be).
- An EME is required to submit a sworn affidavit confirming their annual total revenue of R10 million or less and level of black ownership, an affidavit signed by the EME representative and attested by a commissioner of oaths will be sufficient.

Affidavits submitted by bidders in support of their B-BBEE level should comply with the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) format.

Bidders are hereby advised that the Department shall examine and verify the authenticity of B-BBEE claims made by bidders.

Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) requires that bidders submit original and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or Originally certified copies thereof to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. Failure to do so will result in the bidder being disqualified. Public entities and tertiary institutions must also submit B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates together with their bids.



## **COMPULSORY/MANDATORY TENDER REQUIREMENTS:**

Failure to submit the following required documents will render the bidders tender disqualified:

- The Construction Manager for CIDB level 8 and 9 contractors must hold a minimum BTech degree or NQF Level 7 in Civil Engineering and must be registered and in good standing with ECSA as a Professional Civil Engineer/Professional Civil Engineering Technologist (Pr. Eng. /Pr. Tech Eng) OR SACPCMP as a Professional Construction Manager (Pr. CM). The prospective bidders must submit proof of registration with the mentioned professional bodies. Recently certified copies (within 3 months of tender closing) of the professional registration certificate indicating the applicable registration number must be attached/ submitted as part of bidders' tender documents
- The Safety Officer must be registered and in good standing with the SACPCMP as a Safety Officer or Safety Manager (registration as a Candidate will not be accepted).
