# 2. SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL FENCE AND MUNICIPALITY'S MAIN BUILDING

#### The scope of works entails but not limited to;

- ✓ The supply and installation of electrical fence at municipality's main building with an overall perimeter of approximately 445 meters
- ✓ The following information is proved hereto as additional information for referral purposes.

#### **ENEGIZER**

Contractor to supply and install 1! Druid 18, including master earth grid of three (4) galvanized earth rods and lighting protection on both feed and return cables. Power will be provided not more than 500mm from the energizer (by Worker Collection Point) in the form of a standard v20v socket. Must include a GSM management and remote control for monitoring.

Remote Switch Management energizers must be fitted with a remote switch that operates on a GSM.

#### **CABLES**

Contractor must supply and install all feed cables and under gate cables installed in minimum of 20mm conduit and buried 300mm (feed cables) and 500mm (under gate cables) below ground level. Furthermore all other feed cables to be surface mounted in OHS Inc Copyrighted Material 20mm conduit with saddles at 500mm-1000mm centers using nail in anchors (304 grade stainless steel); all HT cables must be sealed either with adhesive tape and / or cold solder. Weatherproof housing (wall mounted) including space for lightning diverters and remote switch; mounted indoors with lightning diverter housing and existing fence system to be used.

#### **CORNER & INTERMEDIATE BRACKETS**

Corner brackets to be 19mm x 19mm x 1.6mm galvanized square tube bracket, fixed to existing fence structures. At not more than 60m centres and all changes in direction/ corners using stainless screws or yellow passivity self-drilling screws with screw caps to best protect against corrosion. Nail of insulators with 4 electric wires to replace barb wire. Barb wire to be placed/installed on the bottom of the fence. Intermediate brackets to be 19mm x 19mm x 16mm galvanized square brackets, fixed to existing fence structures. At not more than 60m centres and all changes in direction/ corners using stainless steel screws or yellow passivity self-drilling screws with screw caps to best protect against corrosion. Brackets must be installed at approximately 3m centres. Fence Wire: 1.2mm 316 grade stainless steel wire.

#### STRAINER & TENSIONER

Strainer & Tensioner to receive Plastic hybrid compression spring tensioners (reducing the use of dissimilar metals) and 6mm stainless steel ferrule joins as well as the Insulators to be black plastic quick fit bobbins / Jurassic insulators pre-fitted to bracket.

#### **FENCE EARTHS**

Contractor must supply and install Fence earths, which conforms to Copper plated/ galvanized 1200mm earth rods installed at 30m centres along the fence line with slim line HT cable; all cables to be installed as per the manufacturer specifications.
