8 Specification/Scope of Work

8.1 **Description of work**

Supply and delivery of 20 kVA generator consumables the Upington depot.

8.1.1 This project specification is for the supply and deliver 20 kVA generator consumables
Upington depot

8.2 Guarantee and defects

- 8.2.1 The contractor shall guarantee the satisfactory operation of the supplied equipment and accept liability for maker's defects that may appear in design, materials and workmanship.
- The guarantee period for the installed equipment shall expire after a period of 12 months from the day which the equipment was received by Transnet Freight Rail.
- 8.2.3 Any defects identified during the 12 month guarantee period shall be rectified to the satisfaction of Transnet Freight Rail and the contractor shall incur associated cost on his own account.
- 8.2.4 Should the contractor fail to comply with the requirements stipulated above, Transnet Freight Rail shall be entitled to undertake the necessary repair work or effect replacement of defective apparatus or materials, and the contractor shall reimburse Transnet Freight Rail the total cost of such repair or replacements, including the labour costs incurred in replacing defective material or equipment.
- Any specific type of fault occurring three times or more, within the guarantee period and which cannot be proven to be due to other faulty equipment not forming part of the contract faulty locomotive or overhead track equipment, etc. shall automatically be deemed an inherent defect. Such inherent defect shall be fully rectified to the satisfaction of the Project Manager and at the cost of the bidder.
- 8.2.6 If urgent repairs have to be carried out by Transnet Freight Rail staff to maintain operational requirements during the guarantee period, the contractor shall inspect such repairs to ensure that the guarantee period is not affected and should they be covered by the guarantee, reimburse Transnet Freight Rail the cost of material and labour.

8.3 Quality inspection and payments

- 8.3.1 The contractor shall take every precaution to protect the equipment against damage of any kind.
- 8.3.2 Transnet Freight Rail will arrange Public Liability Insurance were deemed necessary.
- 8.3.3 Transnet Freight Rail shall, where deemed necessary, inspect the equipment under the contract at the premises of the manufacturer or successful contractor prior to the equipment being delivered on site. It is the contractor's responsibility to notify Transnet Freight Rail's project manager seven (7) days in advance of the inspection date.

8.3.4 A final inspection of the equipment will be done after the contractor has notified the Project Manager in charge of the project that the equipment has been purchased. If the equipment is found to be satisfactory, a Certificate of Completion will be issued and the contract will be considered completed.

8.4 Finance

8.5.1 Penalty for late completion:

If the contractor does not meet the stipulated delivery date a penalty of R200.00 per day shall be imposed for every day or part thereof for late completion.

8.5.2 Value Added Tax:

The tendered rated in the schedule of quantities and prices must exclude VAT. VAT will be calculated and added to the total at the bottom of the schedule of Quantities and Prices.

- 8.5.3 The contractor must submit his tax invoice once a month for the work done to date. The deadline date of submission will be communicated to the contractor and the contractor must ensure that these timelines are adhered to.
- 8.5.4 The Technical Officer shall conduct a quality inspection before the tax invoice has been submitted. The technical officer reserves the right to withhold payments if the works done are below standards stipulated in this specification.

9 Legal review

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business.

10 Security clearance

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the goods and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

11 National Treasury's Central Supplier Database

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Transnet is required to ensure that price quotations are invited and accepted from prospective bidders listed on the CSD. 12 Tax Compliance

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Respondents tax obligations.

The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to foreign Respondents/ individuals who wish to submit bids.



1.4 STEP FOUR: Post Tender Negotiations (if applicable)

- Respondents are to note that Transnet may not award a contract if the price offered is not market-related. In this regard, Transnet reserves the right to engage in PTN with the view to achieving a market-related price or to cancel the tender. Negotiations will be done in a sequential manner i.e.:
 - o first negotiate with the highest ranked bidder or cancel the bid, should such negotiations fail,
 - o negotiate with the 2nd and 3rd ranked bidders (if required) in a sequential manner.
- In the event of any Respondent being notified of such short-listed/preferred bidder status, his/her bid, as well as any subsequent negotiated best and final offers (BAFO), will automatically be deemed to remain valid during the negotiation period and until the ultimate award of business.
- Should Transnet conduct post tender negotiations, Respondents will be requested to provide their best and final offers to Transnet based on such negotiations. A final evaluation will be conducted in terms of 80/20 and the contract will be negotiated and awarded to the successful Respondent(s).

1.5 STEP FIVE: Objective Criteria (if applicable)

Transnet reserves the right to award the business to the highest scoring bidder/s unless objective criteria justify the award to another bidder. The objective criteria Transnet may apply in this bid process include:

- Geographical location;

1.6 STEP SIX: Award of business and conclusion of contract

- Immediately after approval to award the contract has been received, the successful or preferred bidder(s) will be informed of the acceptance of his/their Quotation by way of a Letter of Award. Thereafter the final contract will be concluded with the successful Respondent(s).
- Otherwise, a final contract will be concluded and entered into with the successful Bidder at the acceptance of a letter of award by the Respondent.

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SECTION 8: SBD 9- CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION
