award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;

award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;

split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;

cancel the bid process;

SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

1 BACKGROUND

Transnet Engineering Wagons Manufacturing does not have an existing contract for these components and from time-to-time TE Supply chain procurement officers must approach the market on RFQ's and appoint the awarded bidder for that specific requirement. This in turn creates some instability in the supply of the cement wagons and this can negatively affect production and the delivery of cement to TFR Clients. Moreover, the prices of these components vary from each RFQ issued to the next as opposed to having a fixed contract price for a fixed duration.

Transnet Engineering Wagons Bloemfontein factory needs approval to approach the external market to source and appoint the appropriate service provider for the supply of the listed critical product (s) for the Fleet Renewal and Maintenance of the XB Wagons on a contractual agreement for a period of three years. The total number of (TFR) Client fleet is 1995 wagons that run through our facilities and infrastructures to service clients' requirements. TE will also be in a better position of having fixed contractual costs that can be negotiated and reviewed through Transnet SCM Contract Review processes.



SECTION 10: PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION
