NB: OBJECTIVE CRITERIA

Service providers must meet the minimum threshold percentage for local production and content for the Steel Products and content for Steel Production and components for Construction for 100% in accordance with the terms of regulation 11 of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017.

Only local produced goods or services that meet the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content as determined by DTI will be considered for acceptance. Any tender that does not meet the minimum threshold is an unacceptable tender.

This tender will be evaluated on the 80/20 preferential procurement policy framework Act (PPPFA). The evaluation criteria will be based on the following functionalities:

The Inkosi Langalibalele Municipality subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Regulations, pertaining to the preferential procurement policy framework act (PPPFA) principles whereby a tenderer's submission will be evaluated according to the sum of the award of points in respect of the tender value and the B-BBEE status of the tenderer. The tender will be evaluated on 80/20 as per the PPPFA Regulations and shall be based on pre-qualification, functionality and price. Bidders are required to submit a fully completed tender document issued by the Inkosi Langalibalele Local Municipality accompanied by a Company Profile, company's CSD (Central Supplier Database) Report, CIPC Documents, Certified Identity Documents of all Directors, Letter of Good Standing from the Department of Labour, valid CIDB Grading Certificate, Valid copy of the Tax Clearance PIN from the Receiver of Revenue, Rates and Taxes Statement obtainable from the Local Municipality, alternatively, Valid Lease Agreement. Please note that the onus is upon the tenderer to ensure that the Tax matters are **always** up to date.

Service providers operating in exempted areas shall submit an exemption letter obtainable from a Local Municipality.
