**Eastern Province begin their title charge against the Falcons as the road to championship glory gets underway**

EP rugby's relentless pursuit of achieving its holy grail of Currie Cup Premier Division promotion kicks off on March 6 when they face a dangerous Falcons outfit in a SA Cup clash at the Nelson Mandela Bay Stadium in Gqeberha.

Ascension to the top flight of SA rugby has been a burning ambition for EP president George Malgas for several years, and the men in red and black hoops will go flat out to achieve their goal and bring pride back to the region in 2026.

A new-look EP side will be up against all SA's non-franchise teams, including the Cheetahs, Pumas, Griquas and a revamped and ambitious Boland Cavaliers outfit in the SA Cup.

EP, who finished seventh in the 2025 edition of the tournament, must finish among the top four clubs in the 10-team SA Cup to earn promotion.

After their opening match against the Falcons, EP travel to play a formidable Pumas outfit at the Mbombela Stadium on March 14.

One of EP's four home matches is a derby showdown against arch-rivals Border Bulldogs in Gqeberha on April 24.

When EP announced several new additions to their squad at the end of 2025, EP head coach Allister Coetzee said he

was happy with the direction the Elephants were moving.

"There has been complete buy-in from the executive about the direction in which EP wants to go," Coetzee said.

"When I was appointed here last year in mid-November, I said I was not a magician and it is a process. That year was ba-

sically to see what is happening in the EP rugby landscape.

"We always knew this was a sleeping giant of a province, and I want to get every arrow pointing in the same direction. EP are looking at 2027 to make sure we get into the Currie Cup Premier Division — that is our target. But there is

nothing wrong with getting there in 2026.

"The start of our present pre-season was on October 1, so everything is improving and heading in the right direction."

The Boland Cavaliers, who will be one of EP's main rivals in the race for promotion, have

# Lions want to roar on home turf in Jukskei derby

The Lions will be desperate to erase an unwanted statistic behind their name when they face the Bulls in a United Rugby Championship clash at Ellis Park on Saturday (kick-off 2.30pm).

In four previous URC meetings at Johannesburg's iconic stadium, the Bulls have emerged triumphant in the Jukskei derby, and Lions coach Ivan van Rooyen is yearning to end this dismal run.

The Lions pulled off a stunning 43-33 win over the Bulls at Loftus at the end of 2025, and this will have raised hopes in the Lions camp that they have the firepower needed to end the Bulls' dominance.

In their previous two matches in Europe, the Lions drew 20-20 against Perpignan in the Champions Cup and were then held to a 24-24 draw by the Ospreys in Wales in a United Rugby Championship clash.

"It was a tough 24-hour trip back to SA after the Ospreys match, and we arrived at 1am on Sunday," Van Rooyen said.

"There is a mental freshness and physical freshness that we want to drive this week and then get up for a really tough game against the Bulls this weekend."

"The on-field temperature was -5°C in Wales, and the wind was blowing 60km/h in that second half."

"However, we spoke about embracing the tough times and conditions."

"We came through so much over the last couple of years that we feel you can reveal who and what you are."

"So, I am very proud of the effort, the toughness."

"The difference between three points and five points out of the game was our discipline in the second half."

Stighling, who has played for the Bulls and the Pumas, has returned to SA rugby after a stint in Major League Rugby with the Seattle Seawolves.

"Jade is a very well-rounded player. He has no weaknesses in his skill set," Boland coach Hawies Fourie said. "He is good in the air, a good finisher, very fast, and a hard-working guy, and a good team man. He is the kind of player we are looking for."

"He will add a lot of value because he is an experienced player and has a good attitude. He also has a good influence on the guys around him."
