Five power stations (namely Arnot, Duvha, Lethabo, Majuba and Tutuka) were previously selected in the Eskom iLanga Photovoltaic (PV) roll-out programme as reference sites for the development and installation of ground mounted PV systems with a total estimated capacity of 246.6 MW. Prior work concluded Environmental Impact Assessments (EIAs) and these sites all have valid Environmental Approvals (EAs). The sites are located close to Eskom power stations and Eskom owns the land on the proposed sites. Eskom will engage with the relevant authorities to secure extensions to these EAs as well as seeking capacity allocation in terms of section 34 of the Electricity Regulations Act of 2006. The utility-scale ground-mounted solar PV renewables projects to be implemented at the following Eskom iLanga PV Power Station sites are presented below:


