1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE

The Ethics Management and Forensic Services ("Forensic Services") is a division with the Group Audit and Risk under the executive leadership of the Chief Audit Executive. Forensic Services derives its mandate from the City's Audit Charter, which mandate is sourced from section 67(1)(i) of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000, section 171(4) and 172(3) of the Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003, Municipal Regulations on Financial Misconduct and Criminal Proceedings.

Forensic Services is a specialist unit which assist the Council, Mayoral Committee, Audit Performance Committee, Board of Directors, City Manager and CEO's to discharge their legislative mandate of creating an ethical culture, Financial Crime Prevention; Detection, Forensic Investigations and facilitation of consequence management. Consequence management includes financial loss recoveries, employee disciplinary actions, referral of criminal cases to the South African Police Services and the review of the system of internal controls.

The purpose of this request for a quotation is to appoint a service provider, to manage the Fraud hotline on behalf of Group Audit and Risk Department.

In terms of the Municipal Regulations on Financial Misconduct and Criminal Proceedings of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000, the City must establish and maintain a system in which persons can anonymously report known or suspected incident.

In order to give effect to this requirement, the City hereby invite prospective bidders to submit proposal on the independent management of the City's Fraud Hotline facilities in accordance with the provisions of the Protected Disclosure Act, Act. No. 26 of 2000, the Regulations of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 and the City's Whistleblowing Policy.

2. PROJECT SCOPE

When providing the cost, fees must be monthly and broken down for all main activities in the proposal (i.e. monthly retainer fee, set-up fee, excess calls fee, and other fees we might be expected to pay during the contract period). The monthly estimated number of calls is 250. The cost for the last month of service (at the end of the contract) should provide for 30-day hand-over fee.

The City may exercise the right to inspect the Call Centre as part of the evaluation criteria and during the operation of the contract.

The quotation must cover but not be limited to the following specifications:

Hosting the City's Fraud Hotline service at its own facility and providing call reports.

The service shall consist of the following mechanisms to facilitate anonymous reporting:

- a) Hosting the Toll-free number 080 874 9263 at own facilities.
- b) Providing a WhatsApp and telegram functionality either on above number or a new one.
- c) A web-based functionality.

The Call Centre facility should be operational and available 24/7 in at least four (4) official languages, with preference given to those dominating within the City's demarcation areas. In the submission, the bidder must indicate the official languages that the Call Centre is able to take calls on.

All reports received by the service provider must be translated into English. The information must be summarised into a disclosure report, which must be uploaded into the case management system within twenty-four hours of the disclosure having been received.

Where a call is received advising of a danger to a person or persons, or of an imminent threat to assets of the City, the service provider will immediately upon completion of the call, make use of the most appropriate reporting medium to contact the designated contact persons or the City's Metro Police Department urgently.

A monthly summary and report of the disclosures received by the service provider during the month must be emailed to the designated contact persons within seven days of month – end.

A monthly analysis report of reported cases should be emailed to the designated contact persons of the City, 7 days after the end of each month

Calls that are of an abusive, scurrilous, or malicious nature or that fall outside the scope of the Forensic Investigation service should be filtered out by the service provider using its best judgment and discretion. Such filtered-out calls should however

be included in the monthly report mentioned above and details be made available to the Council on request.

The service provider will retain all information, records, and/or documentation, whether written, verbal, or electronic, pertaining to reported disclosure for the duration of the contract plus a period of 6 months after termination. Such information must always be treated as confidential.

The service provider will consider all information received from any third party as confidential and will not disclose any such information except to the designated persons for the purposes intended.

The service provider must perform the following case management functions:

- Allocation of a reference number
- Follow up on reported cases.

- 3.1. Hosting the City's Fraud Hotline number at own facilities.
- 3.2. Provision and/or hosting of a WhatsApp/telegram facilities.
- 3.3. Receiving calls.
- 3.4. Call report on each received call.
- 3.5. Monthly statistics of calls report.

4. Objectives of Hotline

- 4.1. Prevention and detection of fraud, corruption, non-compliance with regulations, general misconduct, financial misconduct and general irregularities
- 4.2. Investigation of fraud, corruption, non-compliance with regulations, general misconduct, financial misconduct and general irregularities.
- 4.3. Establish and maintain a mechanism for the anonymous reporting of known or suspected incidents of the above.
- 4.4. Ethics promotion and awareness.

to deliver will be handled in terms of the contract, including performance warnings and listing on the database of restricted suppliers.

The City further reserves the right to negotiate a market-related price with a tenderer scoring the highest points. If the tenderer does not agree to a market-related price, the city reserves the right to negotiate a market-related price with the tenderer scoring the second highest points, if the tenderer scoring the second highest points does not agree to a market-related price, negotiate a market-related price with the tenderer scoring the third highest points. If a market-related price is not agreed upon, the city reserves the right to cancel the quotation.
