a. Overview

The Makhuduthamaga Local Municipality invites experienced and suitably qualified service providers to submit bids for the provision of **repairs and maintenance services** related to **water and sanitation infrastructure**. The appointed service providers will be required to carry out works **on an as-and-when-required basis** over a contract period of **three (3) years**.

b. Key Responsibilities may include (but are not limited to):
