#### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

#### PROVISION OF B-BBEE ADVISORY SERVICES

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The National Housing Finance Corporation (NHFC) was established by the National Department of Human Settlements as a development finance institution (DFI) in 1996, with the principal mandate of broadening access to affordable housing finance for the low- and middle-income households.

NHFC is a national public entity, the NHFC adheres to the regulatory framework of the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) of 1999.

The NHFC provides wholesale funding in the affordable housing market mainly to social housing institutions, non-banking retail intermediaries, privately owned property developers, construction companies and investors. It also provides loans and other form of wholesale funding (equity and quasi equity) to certain niche businesses that are in the affordable housing market.

The Department of Human Settlements is in the process of establishing a Human Settlements Development Bank ("HSDB"). The purpose of which is to position the HSDB as a vehicle to provide effective public and private funding, financing support to key segments of the housing market, in the face of considerable market failure, significant need and a declining fiscus. In October 2018, the NHFC merged with two other human settlements DFIs, National Urban Reconstruction and Housing Agency SOC NPC (NURCHA) and Rural Housing Loan Fund SOC NPC (RHLF). The NHFC will serve as a consolidated platform for the establishment of the HSDB. It is envisaged that the NHFC will continue in its existing legal format but will change its constitution documents to conform to the HSDB requirements once established



# 2. PURPOSE OF REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ)

The purpose of this Request for Quotation (RFQ) is to solicit proposals from potential service providers for the provision of B-BBEE Advisory Services. This RFQ document details and incorporates, as far as possible, the tasks and responsibilities of the potential service provider required by NHFC. This RFQ does not constitute an offer to do business with NHFC but merely serves as an invitation to bidders to facilitate a requirements-based decision process.

#### 3. REQUEST FOR QUOTATION BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In its last assessment, the NHFC obtained a Level 8 rating after being discounted from a Level 7 for not reaching Skills element minimum. The NHFC is looking for an experienced B-BBEE consultants that can assist it to move to a Level 1 within a period not longer than three years.

## 4. SCOPE OF WORK

The deliverables for the assignment should include the following, but the list is not exhaustive.

- Formulation of a B-BBEE strategy and a three-year rolling B-BBEE plan for the NHFC to execute the strategy. The plan should include cost implications, specific targets for all applicable elements and B-BBEE Level outcomes.
- Conducting a base-line (an as- assessment) with improvement recommendations.
- Assisting the NHFC with implementation of the above plan (formulated B-BBEE strategy).
- Submission of monthly progress reports against the B-BBEE plan; predictive score and preparing presentations to the executive committee.
- Reporting periodically on progress made on the B-BBEE plan and other B-BBEE developments to management and board committees.
- Collating of verification documentation and assisting with verification readiness throughout the financial year and points validation before finalisation of verification.
- Assisting the NHFC during the verification process.



- Arranging relevant B-BBEE training for the different stakeholders within the company, for example, B-BBEE committee, management, entity-wide, etc.
- Advisory services on all B-BBEE related developments, including on changes on B-BBE laws and regulations.

#### 5. LOCKDOWN OPERATIONS PROVISIONS

Kindly note that due to the Lockdown Regulations, NHFC is operating remotely, therefore service providers should make required provision of virtual meetings and engagements.

#### 6. CONTRACT TERM

The service provider will be required to sign a contract and will be appointed for a duration of thirty- six (36) months. Duration of contract will be based on performance which will be assessed on a quarterly basis and reviewed annually and NHFC's need basis.

#### 7. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Evaluation of bids received will be conducted in three (3) phases as follows:

## Phase 1 - Compulsory Requirements

Bidders will first be evaluated in terms of the gatekeeper/minimum requirements on page 1 of this document. Bidders who do not fulfil all the requirements or do not submit the required documents will not proceed to the next phase of functionality. Those who fulfil all the requirements or have submitted the required documents will be further evaluated on functionality.

## Phase 2 – Functionality

Functionality is worth 100 points. The minimum threshold is 70 points. Bidders who score less than 70 points on functionality will therefore be disqualified. Those who score more than 70 points will be further evaluated in terms of price and preference points (i.e. on the B-BBEE status level of contributor).
