## B. REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF LINE IMPEDANCE STABILIZATION NETWORK (LISN)

### 1. BACKGROUND TO SANSAS

The South African National Space Agency (SANSAS) has a mandate, as outlined in the South African National Space Agency Act, 2008 (Act No 36 of 2008), to co-ordinate and integrate national space science and technology programmes and conduct long-term planning and implementation of space-related activities in South Africa, for the benefit of the citizens of South Africa

As part of the **Houwteq AIT facility upgrade project** the following equipment and/or services are required.

### 2. SCOPE OF WORK

## **C. EVALUATION CRITERIA**

SANSA promotes the concept of “best value” in the award of contracts, as opposed to merely looking for the cheapest price, which does not necessarily provide the best value. Best value incorporates the expertise, experience, and technical proposal of the organization and individuals who will be providing the service and the organizational capacity supporting the project team.

SANSA is committed to achieving Government's transformation objectives in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act.

The value of this bid is estimated to NOT exceed R1 million (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the **80/20** system shall be applicable.

The procedure for the evaluation of responsive tenders is the **Performance, Price, and Preference** method.

Bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points systems, where 80% of points will be determined by price only and 20% of points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the specific goals in accordance with the Table below.

### **1. Preference**

## 2. Eligibility Criteria

**Description:** The tender response must demonstrate the proposed equipment's ability to meet the SANSAS specifications and requirements as per section B.2.

- e. SANS reserves the right to invite bidders to present their bid proposals for final decision or visit the bidders' premises as part of the evaluation process.
